Adora	Take U.S. 81 south of Stoneburg $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles to gravel cross road. Take right over railroad track. Cemetery on left behind old building.
Antioch (Gladys)	Take FM 677 southwest from Saint Jo. Go 9 miles to gravel road. Take right $\frac{1}{2}$ mile. Cemetery on left.
Belcherville	Go past Ringgold cemetery and Boren Cemetery 3 miles. Cemetery on right.
Benton	Take FM 1956 east out of Nocona $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles. Cemetery in pasture behind house.
Boggess	Go to the edge of Saint Jo on FM 677.
Boren	Go past Ringgold Cemetery $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles. Cemetery on left up in pasture.
*Boyles	Turn left coming from Forestburg mailbox that says Chappel; there will be a steel gate surrounded by pecan trees and a small white house on a hill you can see from the highway.
Briar Creek	Take US 59 southwest out of Bowie 3 miles. Take left on Selma Park Rd. #2582, black top road on left $\frac{1}{4}$ mile. Cemetery on left.
Brushy	Take FM 3043 southeast out of Bowie 3 miles. Cemetery on left.
Centerpoint (Fairview) Take US 82 out of Saint Jo 4 miles to gravel road on right. Cemetery on hill.	
Colored	Take FM 1125 south out of Bowie $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles. Cemetery on hill off road on left.
Denver	Take FM 1749 out of Sunset 11 miles. Go left at old Liberty Cemetery sign 5 miles. Cemetery on left.
Desota	Take FM 1125 So. of Bowie 3 miles to 1st dirt road on left. Go $4\frac{1}{2}$ miles till road makes sharp left. Railroad tracks will be on the right. Cemetery across tracks $\frac{1}{4}$ mile.
Duxbury	Take US 82 out of Nocona 8 miles. Take right on a well traveled gravel road. Cemetery no longer there.
Dye Mound	Take FM 677 southwest out of Saint Jo to FM 3206. Go 11 miles. Cemetery on left. Sign on road.
Eagle Point	Take FM 103 north out of Nocona to FM 2634 on right 4 miles. Cemetery on right.

Elm Creek Take FM 2382 out of Saint Jo. Take first well traveled

gravel road to right. Cross Elm Creek. Cemetery behind

William's cabin.

Elmwood On east Nelson Street in Bowie.

Freeman $\frac{1}{4}$ mile behind the New Harp Cemetery.

Fryer Go past Huddleston Cemetery $\frac{1}{2}$ mile. Cemetery on hill on

left.

*Hall On John Willis place in Forestburg.

Greenbrier Take US 82 east out of Nocona 3 miles. Take gravel

road on right. Go 2 miles. Cemetery on left.

Hardy Take FM 677 north out of Forestburg to FM 1630. Take

right 1 mil. Cemetery on left.

Harmony Take FM 1806 and junction of FM 1816. Take left and go

to well traveled gravel road. Cemetery on left 1/8 mile.

*Hawkins On Bill McMahans' place between Antioch Cemetery and

Peabody.

Hedgepeth Take 175 north out of Montague 5 miles. Cemetery on

left off road 75 yards. No road.

Hopewell Take FM 1806 west out of Stoneburg 5 miles. Cemetery

on right.

Illinois Bend A sign at edge of town on 677.

Jackson Take FM 1749 northeast out of Sunset 11 miles. Sign

on road.

Keck Go past Shady Grove 3 miles. Cemetery on left.

Keenon Take FM 1655 south out of Forestburg 5 miles to well

traveled gravel road on right. Take right, cemetery

½ mile on left.

Lake Valley Take FM 1749 northeast out of Sunset 4 miles. Sign on

road.

Liberty Chapel Take FM 2653 to end of pavement. Take right on dirt road

 $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles. Cemetery on right.

Lindale Take FM 1758 $\frac{1}{2}$ mile. Cemetery on left.

Little Hull Go past Hopewell Cemetery 4 miles to 2nd junction of

well traveled road. Take right and cemetery on right.

Lofton Northeast of Saint Jo.

Long Branch Take US 82 west out of Nocona to 2nd well traveled gravel

road on left. Sign on road.

*McCracken In a wooded area overlooking Willa Walla Creek between Forestburg & Hardy Take US 81 north out of Bowie 3 miles. Cemetery on McDonald. right. Sign on road. Take FM 3206 $7\frac{1}{2}$ miles to Clear Creek. Cemetery on McGrady left in woods. Magee Take FM 1655 south out of Forestburg 5 miles. Cemetery on left. Mallard Take FM 677 southeast out of Montague 7 miles. Sign on Mayfield Take 2634 until road makes a y. Take left on FM 2653, go to the end of pavement. Take gravel road on right, continue until road T's. Take a left and Cemetery is on left 1/8 mile. Mitchell. Go past Tage Cemetery to Y in road. Cemetery on left. Molsbee Take FM 1759 north out of Nocona to first well traveled gravel road on right after making left curve. Cemetery on edge of Nocona. Montague Go north of Montague to edge of town. Sign on road. Mt. Creek Take FM 677 north out of Saint Jo. Cross Mt. Creek to first road on right. Cemetery on left. Mt. Park In the city of Saint Jo. Mt. Tabor Take FM 455 southeast out of Montague $4\frac{1}{2}$ miles to 2nd well traveled gravel road on right $\frac{1}{2}$ mile. Cemetery on left. Take dirt road north out of Illinois Bend. Go 2 miles Murrel1 until road makes a sharp left. Cemetery in woods to right off road. Neece Place Take FM 3043 south out of Bowie $4\frac{1}{2}$ miles. Cross bridge over a little creek. Take first dirt road to right about half way up first hill. Cemetery on right 100 yards in woods. New Harp

Take FM 1655 south out of Forestburg 7 miles to first well traveled gravel road on left. Follow road to next gravel road on left 4 mile. Cemetery on left.

Take US 82 west out of Nocona to first well traveled gravel Nocona road to right on edge of town.

Oak Hill Take FM 1806 east out of Stoneburg 5 miles. Cemetery on right. Sign on road.

Perryman Take FM 455 north out of Forestburg 2 miles. Cemetery on right.

Perryman #2 Go northeast of Forestburg. Cemetery is quite a distance

off road through woods.

Pleasant Hill Take FM 1749 northeast out of Sunset 6 miles. Sign on

road.

Poor Farm Take FM 455 west out of Montague $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles by county dump.

Prairie Branch Take US 59 southwest out 5 miles. Sign on road.

Queens Peak Take US 81 north out of Bowie 5 miles to Historical marker.

Take dirt road to right. Go to first well traveled dirt

road and take a right. Cemetery on side of hill.

Red Bud Take FM 1956 and FM 3301. Cemetery on right. Sign on

road.

Red River Station Take FM 1759 north out of Nocona $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles to gravel road.

Keep going 6 miles on gravel road on left. Sign on road.

Reed Take FM 677 north out of Saint Jo to 2nd gravel road on

left. Go to next road on right, turn right, and go $1\frac{1}{2}$

miles. Road on left goes into pasture.

Ringgold Take US 82 east out of Ringgold 2 miles. Cemetery on left.

Robinson Take FM 1956 east out of Nocona 6 miles to gravel road on

right 2 miles. Cemetery on left.

St. Jo Take FM 677 north to edge of town on left.

St. Peters Take FM 1758 3 miles to dirt road on left. Cemetery

just before the curve.

St. Williams Take FM 455 south out of Montague to first well traveled

gravel road on left 3/4 mile. Cemetery on left.

Salona Take FM 1758 7 miles. Sign on road.

Scrougy TAke FM 1749 northeast out of Sunset 8 miles. Sign on road.

Selma Take US 59 southwest out of Bowie 3 miles to black top

road on left. Go to last dirt road on right before boat

ramp. Road goes to Cemetery.

Shady Grove Go past Red Bud on FM 3301. Road runs into a T. Go left

 $\frac{1}{4}$ mile. Cemetery on left.

Simmons Take FM 3301. Go $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles cross Barefoot Branch to house

on left off the road. Cemetery $\frac{1}{4}$ mile behing house in woods.

*Small Go on Sherrie Vanoys land near Forestburg.

Smyrna Take FM 1749 east out of Sunset 4 miles. Sign on road.

Spanish Fort Take FM 103 to edge of Spanish Fort on right.

Spanish Fort #2 Just behind old Spanish Fort Cemetery.

Starkey Take US 82 east out of Nocona 8 miles to well traveled

road on right. Sign on road.

Sunset Take junction US 287 and Cemetery road.

Tage Take US 59 north out of Bowie 7 miles. Sign on road.

Tarter Was 7 miles south of Bowie on FM 1125 and was moved to

Elmwood.

Tompkins Near Dye Mound; Jim Ned lookout is near by

Totty Between Sunset and Forestburg on Denton Creek

Traylor Take FM 922 southeast out of Forestburg 5 miles. Cross

Bingham Creek and go $\frac{1}{2}$ mile. Cemetery across field in

woods.

Union Take FM 1956 out of Caps Corner to first well traveled

gravel road on right. Go to end of road.

Wickliffe Take first well travled gravel road to right out of

Illinois Bend $6\frac{1}{2}$ miles to brick house on left. Cemetery

at house.

Wilson Take FM 103 north out of Nocona. Go past FM 2634 and past

FM 2849 until road makes a sharp right, then sharp left, and then another sharp right. Take first well traveled dirt road to left 7 miles. Cemetery on left behind old

farm house on edge of creek.
